<p>Excursions MAXIMUM COST PER STUDENT</p> <p>This is a charge for optional activities outside school grounds related to specific learning activities which are available to all students in a class or selected students and then only if the payment is made immediately prior to the excursion. Individual lunches may need to be ordered and paid.</p>	\$200
