## PRINCIPAL REPORT



Swimming lessons are well under way. The move to Chinamans Beach was a good one as the water is a lot more pleasant to swim in.

Thank you to parents who have come into their respective class meetings. The key messages that have been given out are:

**Attendance:** every day counts. It is not fair on children if they miss school and then have to try and catch up.

**On Time:** children feel very uncomfortable when they are late and walk into their class having missed part of the morning routine. Start time for secondary students is 8.30am. Primary classes officially begin at 8.40am although our dedicated teachers have their classes open well before that and there are activities and routines happening. Too good to miss.

**Sign in:** adults who are on site during the day are asked to sign in and out. This is a security process in place in all education facilities.

**Reading:** reading is still the most valuable form of homework. Whilst I heard some teachers say they don't send home homework sheets, they all said to encourage reading.

**Cyber Use and Social Media:** all parents are encouraged to monitor the use of these at home. Set the example and encourage your children to play in our fantastic outdoors environment.

**School Fees and Charges:** please pay your contributions early in the year so that we can use them for your children. The Fees and Charges go a long way towards supplementing the amount we receive from the Government to run the school.

**Keep in Touch:** All teachers welcome you to contact them if you have anything you wish to discuss. Some teachers have activities first thing in the morning and parents are welcome to join in.

The Dental Van will be at school from April 4<sup>th</sup>. Further information will go out closer to the time.

Each year we host a footy game with Clontarf. They will be here Thursday, 22<sup>nd</sup> February and students have been invited to join the team to play against them.
