## UPCOMING EVENTS

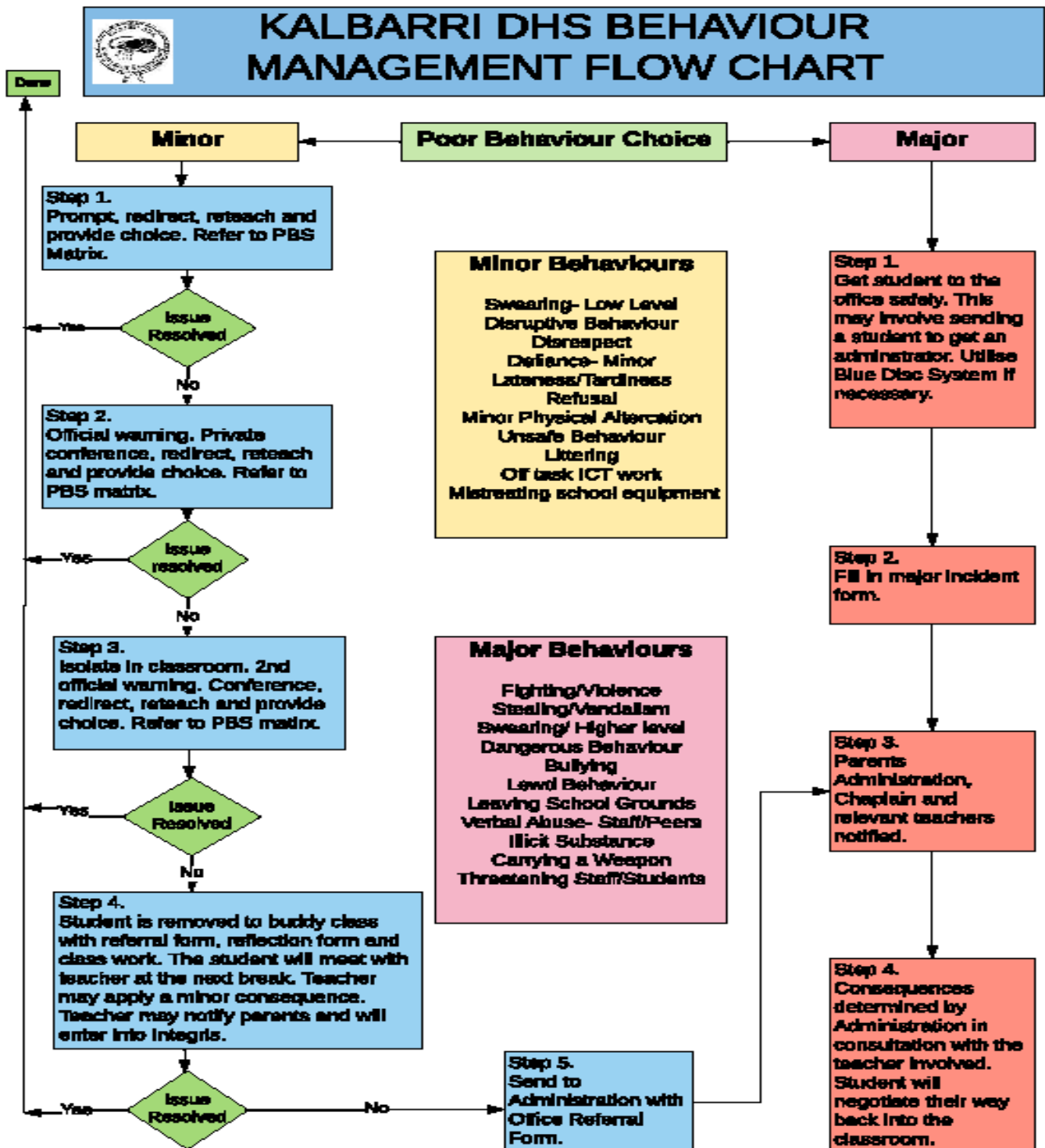
